Teddy Bears, Lunch, and a Whole Lot of Heart:

Community Bank & Trust Launches Feel-Good Movement to Lift Spirits Across LaGrange

- Harmony House Domestic Violence Shelter Women and children seeking safety received teddy bears to offer emotional support and a sense of hope during times of transition.
- Poplar Creek Senior Care Seniors were surprised with teddy bears and lunch, bringing smiles and reminding them they are valued members of the community.
- LaGrange-Troup County Homeless Coalition (Branches of Hope Center) –
 Individuals and families experiencing homelessness were given warm meals and teddy bears as a gesture of compassion and dignity.
- CASA of Troup County Children in the foster care system were gifted teddy bears to provide comfort and a sense of stability in challenging circumstances.
- Twin Cedars Youth & Family Services At-risk youth received teddy bears as a reminder that they are seen, supported, and not alone.
